<u>Change4Life – Adventure Booklets</u> One of our school development areas this year is to ensure that are children are as active as possible. We have introduced daily physical activities and this term we are offering a range of opportunities at lunchtimes to encourage children to be more active. Nationally, childhood obesity has reached epidemic levels. In fact, 22% of children are overweight or obese when they start primary school and this increases to 34% by the end of primary school. Sugar is a big part of the problem. If you came to our fabulous twilight all about active lifestyles in October 2018, you will have learnt all about sugar in drinks. Did you know that 4-10 year olds are eating and drinking more than twice the amount of sugar that they should on a daily basis? With all of our help, we can try to change that for our children at All Saints. Your child/children should come home today with an adventure booklet. This is full of facts, stickers and challenges.
