Dear Parents / Carers

As you may be aware, the Sherborne Cluster of small schools arranges a programme of visits for children in Years 2 - 6. Year 3 pupils from Buckland Newton, All Saints Bishops Caundle and Thornford will be visiting the **Carymoor Environmental Trust on Friday 25th May for a Crafty Celts Day.**

This visit is a wonderful opportunity for children to experience realities of life in the past. On arrival, there will be an introduction to Celtic life focusing on the materials and techniques used as craftspeople. The activities for the day will include:-

- Investigating the structure of the replica roundhouse, including the materials and techniques used to build it and what it was like to live in. Make mini roundhouses using natural materials (willow, clay, reeds and rush) to take back to school to make into a Celtic village
- Wattle and Daubing – adding some more daub to the walls of the roundhouse
- Use some Carymoor willow to weave a willow pane(s) to take back to school.
- Have a go at grinding grain into flour with a saddle quern and make damper bread (with other flour!), cooking this on a fire in the roundhouse.

The children will be leaving by coach as follows:-

- 9.00am from Buckland Newton School
- 9.15am from All Saints Primary School
- 9.30am from Thornford Primary School

and will leave Carymoor at 2.35pm to return to Thornford Primary at approximately 3.20pm, All Saints Primary at approximately 3.35pm and Buckland Newton at approximately 3.50pm. Please can you arrange for your child to take:-

- A morning snack and a packed lunch and a drink (in a reusable container please).
- Wellington Boots (in a plastic carrier bag please) or walking shoes/trainers if weather is dry.
- Waterproof clothing if the weather is likely to be wet, layers of clothing are essential and sun hats and sun cream if weather is hot.
- Clean footwear to change into for the return coach journey.
