Dear Parents / Carers,

Sports Day: We were very sorry to have cancelled Sports Day this morning. However, grey skies loomed, the forecast wasn't great and the field was extremely wet and slippery. So... fingers crossed now for our reserve date of Friday 28th June.

New Reception Intake: This week we also welcomed our new reception children for September into All Saints as they enjoyed their first visit to school. We hope they had a lovely time and are looking forward to coming back next Wednesday!

Swimming and Verrucas: We are so delighted that all the children have been able to enjoy swimming lessons this week, despite the very cold weather. There have been some discussions around verrucas and swimming and I would like to share with you the advice from British Swimming on this subject. 'Warts on the feet called verrucas have long been seen as a nuisance. Much has been done in the past to try and rid pools of these 'plantar warts' (so-called because they grow on the plantar or bottom of the foot) all to no avail.

The use of devices, such as plastic socks, to protect the feet should be discouraged. The socks have limited value other than of attracting attention. The use of a waterproof plaster is sufficient. Most enlightened associations and professional bodies believe the exclusion of children with plantar warts from barefoot activities - such as swimming, physical education or dancing - is no longer justified.'
