To clarify, each morning the main doors will be closed at 8.55am. All latecomers must report to the school reception with their parents/carers who must then register the children in a Late Arrivals book.

**Post Box in Reception Area:** As the school office seems to get busier and busier, we have introduced a new post box in the front reception area just to the right of the front door. Should you forget to hand any consents, club bookings or trip money to the member of staff on the children's entrance you can now pop them in this secure post box. Please remember that all money should be secured in a named envelope.

**Cloakrooms:** Large rucksacks seem to be reappearing in the children's cloakroom so this is just a reminder that only drawstring bags and book bags are allowed in school. Also, bundles of keyrings seem to be appearing on bags which is proving to be a distraction especially for our younger children. Please can we therefore ask that keyrings be limited to one per bookbag. Thank you for your support.
