Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you are keeping well.

It has been great to hear about and see so many pupils taking part in the 'sports day' this week; it has brought smiles to so many faces. Many thanks to Lisa Regan for organising this and for you in supporting the event.

I am still awaiting final clarification from Dorset Council, however, as it stands, it looks like this academic year will end for the pupils on Friday 17th July 2020 and that the school will not be open through the summer holiday period. It seems that some provision, away from the school, will be made available for vulnerable pupils over this period and that there will be local -paid- holiday clubs for the children of key workers to use. This will be consistent across the county. As a school, we will not be setting work over the summer holiday period.
