- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit

will in all probability be entitled to additional support for their child (this includes free school meals throughout their schooling and money to spend on equipment, uniform, trips, clubs If you believe that you may fall in to this category, either:

- Pop in and see Lou in the Office with your NI number.

You will then immediately find out if you are eligible for this additional funding.

PICKING UP AT THE END OF THE DAY

With the safeguarding of our pupils paramount, we are always looking to sharpen up our practices. Could I please remind parents/guardians that if someone different is picking up at the end of the day, please let Lou in the Office know. At this early part of the year, when staff are still getting to know your faces, please be understanding if we have to confirm who you are. Better safe than sorry!

MORNINGS

If you have any messages at the start of the day, could I ask you to please pass them to the member of staff on duty at the main Children's Entrance or email the School Office. Our morning routine is generally the busiest part of the day for our staff (settling pupils, setting them off with their learning, generating a positive learning environment...) and they, unfortunately, will not have the time to dedicate to queries or concerns from parents. Staff will, however, get back to you at the earliest possible opportunity about any issue raised. In addition, I am generally available at the start of the day to deal with any issues.

COMMUNICATION

Teachers do not read with every pupil every day so messages written in Reading Records may be missed. If you have a message for any member of staff, please call in or email Lou in the School Office.

COATS

With the weather due to deteriorate over the next few weeks, please ensure that the children have a coat with them when they come into school.

PE FOOTWEAR

As often as possible, at least one PE session each week will be outside. Please be aware that it is strongly recommended that pupils have training shoes rather than plimsolls for outside sessions.

PUPIL VOICE

We are so lucky that our dedicated staff give up their lunchtimes to run clubs and committees which give pupils the opportunity to contribute their ideas (and the ideas of their classmates) on how to make life better for our school community and people elsewhere in the local community and the wider world.
