Dear Parent / Carers,

<u>Cloakroom space</u> - This is NOT our school but you can see the problem!



Due to the rise in the number on roll at All Saints, our cloakroom space is under extreme pressure! We have been trying to manage this but have arrived at the conclusion that the measures described below will improve things greatly and therefore need to be put in place.

Therefore we really need you to help us in the following ways:

• I am afraid that we simply <u>cannot</u> accommodate rucksacks in the space we have, therefore children should only bring a book bag to school (that will also accommodate any home learning) and their lunch (if not having a hot meal) which is then stored in the kitchen during the morning. Book bags can be taken into class leaving coats and PE bags only in the cloakroom.

• PLEASE ensure that PE kits are contained in <u>drawstring</u> bags ONLY. (School branded bags can be purchased through our school uniform supplier.) These can hang on pegs easily with coats. For Health and Safety reasons we are not allowed to store bags on the floor.

• PLEASE ensure the loop by which the coat is hung is mended when broken. Coats hung by their hoods do not stay put in the space available.

Thank you so much for your co-operation with this – this will really help us not to lose valuable learning time dealing with cloakroom issues.

PE Kits – a plea for support!

Please remember that children need their PE kits in school. Every **Wednesday** the school employs a Sports Coach and it is essential that each child receives this specialist provision. We are finding that despite regular reminders that a considerable amount of children do not have their basic kit in school.

- Please ensure that coats, PE bags and PE clothing are clearly named so that we can return any lost items to the children quickly.
- PLEASE include a plastic carrier bag in PE bags for muddy trainers!
