Behaviour

- In order for all children to enjoy clubs after school, poor behaviour choices will not be tolerated. If a child is unable to manage their behaviour appropriately then they will be removed from that activity. Please support this by reminding your children attending clubs that the highest standards of behaviour are expected. Thank you.
