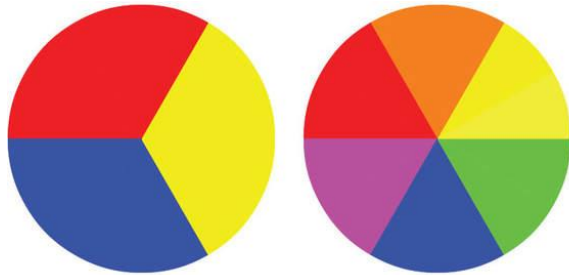


Autumn 1- Art Knowledge Organiser: Piet Mondrian and Paul Klee

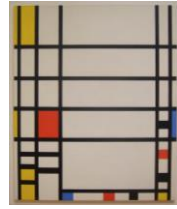
Primary colours- Colours that can't be made by mixing other colours together.



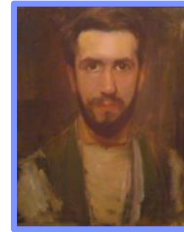
Primary Colours

Secondary Colours

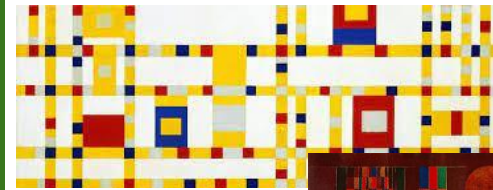
Secondary colours- Colours that can be made by mixing primary colours together.



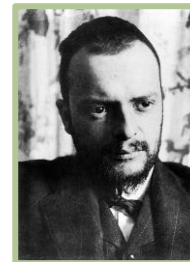
Piet Mondrain- Born in the Netherlands 1872. His first job was a teacher but enjoyed painting. His first paintings were of landscapes. He became interested in abstract art. He liked painting with primary colours with black lines and white spaces.



Abstract art- Made of lines, shapes and colours. Not a picture of something specific.



Paul Klee- Born in Switzerland 1879. He wanted to be an artist but was worried he couldn't make his paintings realistic. He decided to paint more abstract art. He experimented with lots of different colours.



Tints- Adding white to colours to create lighter tints.
