

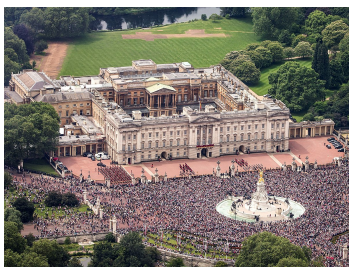

Key vocabulary:

moat - a deep, wide ditch surrounding a castle

mere - a lake or pool, used for fishing

keep - a tower, the strongest part of a castle

bailey - the outer wall surrounding a castle or the keep

courtyard - an area with no roof, surrounded by walls or buildings
