Morning drop-off arrangements:

 Reception children enter the school via their classroom door with their parents/carers as part of the Early Years provision.

- We would really appreciate your support with children from Year 1 to Year 6 entering the school in the morning via the Children's Entrance at the front of the school. A member of staff will be here to greet them and take any messages from you.
- Our cloakroom area is small and crowded and we would appreciate the children being encouraged to be
 independent in their start of day routine. Therefore generally please could adults not enter the cloakroom
 with children. If you need to speak to the class teacher on an urgent matter please let the adult on the door
 know. Thank you!
- With an increased number on roll our drop-off is becoming busier. If you are using the drive through road service you must drop children and drive on.
- Cars must not be left unattended with the engine running. If you need to speak to someone, please park outside of the school and walk in.

Emails – For the transfer of information we would welcome communication by email, which can be received via the office email or the link on our website. Emails can then be quickly forwarded to the relevant staff member.

We completely understand that there will be occasions when you need to speak with teaching or support staff and you are encouraged to do so directly, rather than via the office please. Additionally and when appropriate, if you need to request a meeting with a member of staff this can also be arranged via email.

Spare socks - With oncoming winter weather and outside PE please ensure all children have long trousers and spare socks as part of their PE kits next half term. Girls wearing tights often forget these!

Breakfast and Afterschool Clubs: The new programme for the next half term has now been launched and I am delighted to confirm that we have some new afterschool clubs on offer.
