Dear Parents,

I hope you are all pleased to see your children home from Weymouth. We have got some exciting weeks ahead before your child unfortunately leaves us, including our school production. Your child has brought home their lines for their production 'Tuishi Pamoja', which is on Wednesday and Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> July at 7pm. Your child will need to be at All Saints for 6:40pm on both evenings. Tickets will be on sale at the end of the week from the school office. We hope you can make it and we are sure you will enjoy the show! Most of the costumes are being taken care of, however we may be asking you to find, for example a black t-shirt.
