a tall tower with a bright light that warns ships about rocks.



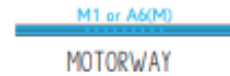
Port

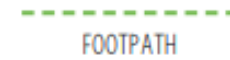

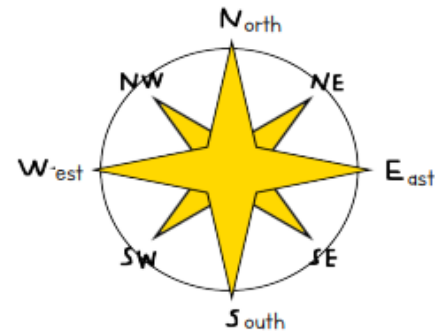
