<b>Ensure the quality of provision, monitoring:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Curriculum coverage</li><li>• Quality of teaching</li><li>• Fluency at the start of every lesson</li><li>• Quality of pupil work</li><li>• Range of work</li><li>• Enrichment opportunities</li><li>• Subject files to reflect what is happening in each subject</li><li>• Subject stories to be developed and used to assist with fluency in each subject</li></ul>		<b>Each half term</b>	
<b>Monitor the pupil knowledge (fluency) in their subject :</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pupil interviews to check their knowledge</li><li>• Pupils should be able to talk about the subject and their subject journey, including key knowledge</li></ul>		<b>Each term</b>

<b>Non SDP action</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure that staff are evidencing the Working Scientifically objectives and not just logging Knowledge objectives</li></ul>		<b>Each half term</b>
