## Your Child may Be Entitled To Additional Funds

Families who receive:

- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.

- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit

are entitled to additional financial support for their child. This includes free school meals throughout their schooling and money to spend on equipment, uniform, trips, clubs. The school in turn receives extra funding to support the children in their learning. If you believe that you may fall in to this category, either:

- Telephone 01305 221000 (you will need your NI number and child's DOB) or
- Apply on line at https://www.dorsetcouncil.gov.uk/education-and-training/schools-and-learning/at-school/free-school-meals

You will then immediately find out if you are eligible for this additional funding. New applications must be made before 7<sup>th</sup> October for the school to receive this extra funding.
